

How to Prepare for Your Flea Treatment

Thank you for allowing Innovative Pest Solutions to treat and protect your home from fleas. To insure complete elimination of the fleas in your home, it is important for you to take the following steps.

- Remove all toys and clothes from the floor; this includes under the furniture and beds. Our flea treatment consists of treating all the carpeted floor areas and the surface of cloth furniture. Items on the floor will prevent those areas from being treated properly.
- Have your pets treated/dipped for fleas around the same time that your home is treated.
- All pets (esp. birds) need to be removed from house during treatment. Fish tanks can be covered with a towel or blanket and the aerator turned off (don't forget to turn back on when returning).
- Inform technician in what rooms or areas where the pets tend to sleep or rest.
- Vacuum, vacuum, vacuum. This should be done before treatment and as often as possible (once a day) after treatment. This speeds up emergence of fleas and removes some food source for the immature flea (larvae). In a vacant house, vacuuming is a must for flea control.
- You will need to stay out of the house for 3-4 hours to allow chemicals to dry and adhere to the flooring surfaces.
- Because of the flea's life-cycle, it can take 2-3 weeks before total elimination of infestation.
